He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent. For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

Colossians 1:15–20

Christ is the title of our Lord Jesus. We are his Body and He is our Head. All authority in heaven and earth are His. Christ is the Spirit-Anointed King sent by His Father to slay sin and serpent and rescue His Bride to present Her in holiness and splendor.

Fellowship is everlasting union we enjoy by being made right with God in Christ Jesus. Communion with the Triune God by the Father's revelation, the Son's redemption, and the Spirit's regeneration is the basis and bond of our unity and love with one another.

These lines signify pages of an open Bible—Holy Scripture of which Christ is the center. They also represent a timeline—All of history flows to and from the cross. The lines also indicate Christ bringing heaven down to earth—Raised to life on the third day to reconcile us to God.



Canyon is the nearby geographical feature that identifies the primary area where our church gathers. May our Canyon rejoice for, while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son and saved by His life for holiness and good works.

The Cross of Christ signifies the good news that God in Christ saves sinners and has been the enduring symbol of the Christian faith. We look upon this dark instrument of torture with joy, for it is at the cross where God demonstrated His love for us. Therefore, we love to proclaim Christ and Him crucified.

The Canyon, Montana reminds us that Christ bridged the infinite chasm of separation caused by our sinful rebellion to bring us to His Father. Praise God that Christ rescued us out of the canyon of darkness that we may ascend the mountain of the Lord with the King of glory.

This shield indicates that the Lord is our rock, our fortress and our deliverer. He is our rock in whom we take refuge, our shield, our salvation, and our stronghold. (Psalm 18)

Christ is King of cosmos and canyon. Every creature belongs to Him and owes Him allegiance and worship. Therefore, we bring His good tidings that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us, declaring us righteous and securing eternal fellowship with God.
